Peggy was a sister, wife, and friend like no other. Her love and compassion for not only her family, but for everyone was a love like no other. Peggy was one of the most loving, caring, sharing, and always there for your heart and soul no matter what. In fact, Peggy would give her last penny to help someone who had less.
